What is a Hearing Loop?

A hearing loop is a wire that circles a room and is connected to a sound system. The loop transmits the sound electromagnetically. The electromagnetic signal is then picked up by the telecoil in the hearing aid or cochlear implant. Home systems as well as systems for public areas are available. Because many hearing aids come with telecoils, a hearing loop is a relatively long-term, lower cost solution for many hearing impaired patients.
